INTERNET ACCESS ON CAMPUS

There is free Wi-Fi available to all conference delegates. Delegates can log onto NTU–Guest or Nottingham Conference Centre. There is no password; you will need to accept our terms and conditions.

The ntu-guest & NottinghamConferenceCentre wireless networks permit ports 80 and 443 only. This is suitable for most web-based applications. If you require using applications that use different ports (perhaps a VPN that is not web based) then we will need to know the TCP/UDP ports it will use in advance of the conference

Eduroam Wi-Fi is also available across the main campus

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

If possible it would be advisable to travel by public transport – there are excellent train (and air) links between Nottingham and most towns and cities.

Taxis are available outside Nottingham Station (The journey takes 10 minutes and costs approximately £7.00).
