The 2017 Spring Conference will be hosted by Ulster University, Monday 3 April - Wednesday 5 April 2017.

## Airport Transfers

Delegates are responsible for their own airport transfers. There are taxi ranks at both Belfast International and Belfast City Airport. A taxi from Belfast City Airport to Titanic Belfast takes approximately 10 minutes and will cost in the region of £6. The journey to the Europa Hotel will take 15-20 minutes (longer at peak periods) and cost approx. £10.

Transfers from Belfast International Airport will be approximately 40 minutes and cost in region of £25.

## Conference venue/ registration

The Conference is taking place at [Titanic Belfast](#), the world's largest Titanic visitor experience (recently pronounced World's Leading Visitor Attraction 2016).

## Evening functions

The conference's evening functions will take place in two of Belfast's most iconic buildings, Parliament Buildings and Belfast City Hall.

[Parliament Buildings](#), commonly known as Stormont because of its location in the Stormont Estate, is the seat of the Northern Ireland Assembly. The welcome supper will take place in the 'Long Gallery', the location for political announcements and for receiving visiting dignitaries. The evening is being sponsored by Saxon Bampfylde.

The conference gala dinner will be held in [Belfast City Hall](#) by kind permission of the Lord Mayor of Belfast, Alderman Brian Kingston. Located in the heart of Belfast city centre, it first opened its doors in August 1906. A drinks reception hosted by Belfast City Council will be followed by dinner, sponsored by Eversheds Sutherland.

### Dress code

The dress code for both evening functions is business attire. We recommend smart casual wear for conference sessions.
